

Welcome to the Fall 2023 Weston CT Baseball Season!

Welcome new and old families to Weston Baseball for the Fall 2023 season. Registration is now open and regular registration will run through August 27th. Fall baseball is traditionally a time where players and coaches focus on skill development and baseball situational awareness. It is also a time where players can and should explore other sports simultaneously. To that end we have a robust Pro D clinic style program with games / scrimmages mixed in to solidify the skills in a game setting. Additionally, coaches and the board will look to provide those interested an opportunity to play friendly games against local towns at the Minor and Major level.

To those new to the program below is information regarding each of the age groups with more information available on the website.

Our youngest divisions are broken into T-Ball, Rookie Prep and Rookie and include players that are Pre-K through 2nd Grade. The multiple tiers within this division are grade-based, providing for positive social interactions with classmates and ease of scheduling with other sports.

Our older divisions (the Minors and Majors Divisions) are grade and ability based and include players that are in 3rd – 6th Grade and 7th Graders who turn 13 after 5/1/2024. The grouping of players with similar ability provides for the greatest developmental environment for our players while also maximizing player safety.

There will be no baseball during Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur.

T-ball	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Division introduces baseball to our youngest players in a fun and stress-free environment. • Pre-K & K • Practice / Games supported by IST on Saturday at 1PM – 2:00PM
Rookie Prep	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Division continues to focus on fun and fundamentals while taking a big step forward in real gameplay. Coaches will handle pitching duties and provide instruction from the field as players incorporate more aggressive base-running and 3-out innings. • Grade 1 • Coach Pitch • Pro D Clinic – Wednesday after school 3:15PM – 5PM • Practice / Games on Saturday at 1:00PM - 3:00PM • Potentially combined with Rookies based on numbers
Rookies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Division is designed to introduce players to live kid pitching. This is accomplished by playing kid pitch with coach rescue. Additionally, the mound can be moved forward to adapt to the pitcher. • Grade 2 • Kid Pitch, Coach rescue • Pro D Clinic – Thursday after school 3:15PM – 5PM • Practice / Games on Saturday at 1:00PM - 3:00PM • Potentially combined with Rookies based on numbers
Minors Division	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Division continues building and refining fundamental skills while understanding of game strategy is developed. Player pitching is strengthened, base stealing and the infield fly rule introduced for the first time with some moderations to ensure proper game flow. • Grades 3-4. (Kid Pitch, Stealing) • 46/60 Baseball • Pro D Clinic – Thursday 5:00PM – 6:30PM • Practice / Games – Saturday at 11:00AM – 1:00PM
Majors Division	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Division is where players begin to make the adjustment to a more advanced game. Leading, pick off moves, balks and the dropped 3rd strike rule are all introduced at this age. This is also when players begin their transition to a larger field. The pitcher’s mound is 50 feet from home plate, and the bases are 70 feet apart. We will continue to build upon a foundation of fundamental baseball and general athletic skills and may also begin to find specific positions where players can succeed. • Grades 5-7. (Kid Pitch, Leading, Stealing, Balks) • 50/70 Baseball • Pro D Clinic – Thursday 5:00PM – 6:30PM • Practice / Games – Saturday at 11:00AM – 1:00PM
